PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING YOUR CME CREDITS

EUROPE

IMCAS is accredited by the European Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (EACCME) to provide CME accredited activities for physicians. The EACCME is an institution of the European Union of Medical Specialists (UEMS).

USA

- 2. Once completed, submit your application by fax or mail, along with your EACCME Credit Certificate and processing fee. A certificate awarding AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™ will be e-mailed within 4 weeks.
